### ANNUAL MISSION APPEAL 2017

Next week, we will welcome Fr. Henry Tanto, who will speak to us about Catholic Education needs in the remote areas in the Diocese of Kumbo in Africa. About 65% of the population survive on subsistence farming, living in deep poverty. Catholic Education is seen as the only hope to help in teaching peace and justice in their society. However, very few parents can afford the \$50 per year to educate a child in primary school. Many families struggle with the oft-repeated choice: eat tonight or wait until tomorrow and use tonight's food money for school fees. The subsidy system of the Catholic Church is the only way to keep Catholic Education going. We ask that you be generous with the second collection that will be taken up for that cause. Thank you.
