FEAST OF ST. BLAISE

One day a mother brought to St. Blaise her boy, who, while eating, had swallowed a fishbone, which remained in his throat, and, causing great pain, threatened suffocation. St. Blaise prayed and made the Sign of the Cross over the boy, and behold, he was cured. For this reason the Saint is invoked in throat troubles. Therefore the Church, on his Feast, February 3, gives a special blessing, at which is prayed over those receiving it: "By the intercession of St. Blaise, bishop and Martyr, may God deliver thee from all ills of the throat and from all other ills; in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost. Amen."
