RELIGIOUS FREEDOM WEEK

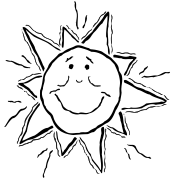

QUO VADIS RETREAT

Sacred Heart of Jesus Church, 18 East Main Street, Webster MA will present, free to the public, a Vatican approved International Exhibition of Eucharistic Miracles of the World on Sunday, June 26th. A short presentation about Eucharistic Miracles will take place at 2:00 p.m. in the church, followed by the exhibit in the parish hall located at 11 Day Street in Webster. The exhibit, which has been shown at more than 3,000 parishes in Italy, the US, Canada, and many other countries, was created and designed by Carlo Acus, a 15 year old from Milan who died of leukemia in 2006. He was beatified in 2020. A first class relic of this young man will be present for vernaon at the exposition.
